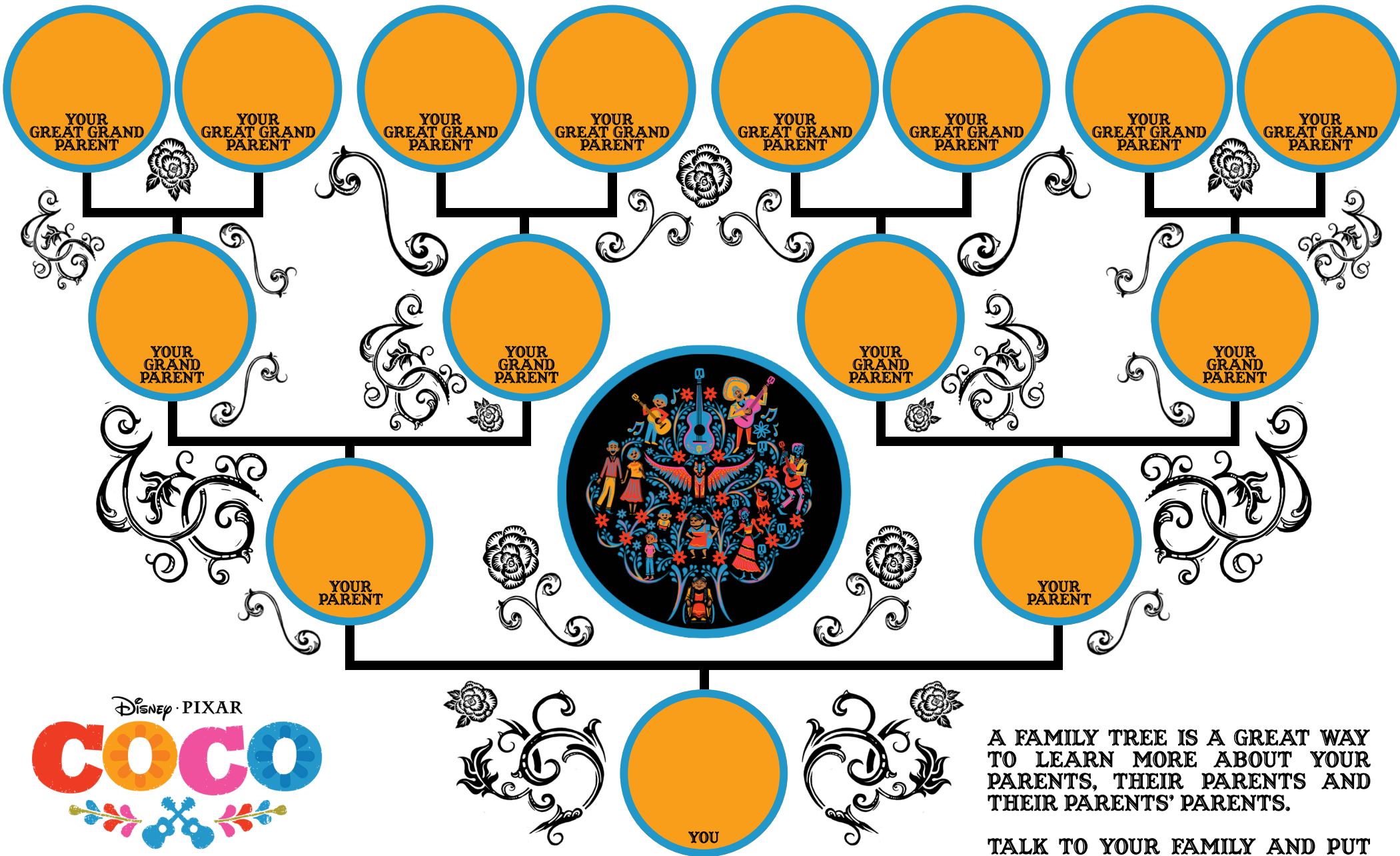

MAKE A HEXAFLEXAGON!

A HEXAFLEXAGON IS A 'MAGIC' MATHEMATICAL SHAPE THAT YOU CAN KEEP FLIPPING INSIDE OUT TO REVEAL HIDDEN PICTURES. FLIP THE HEXAFLEXAGON INTO ITSELF TO REVEAL THE DIFFERENT IMAGES. TO MAKE THE HEXAFLEXAGON, CUT OUT THE THE PIECES FROM THE FOLLOWING PAGES AND ASSEMBLE IT AS SHOWN.



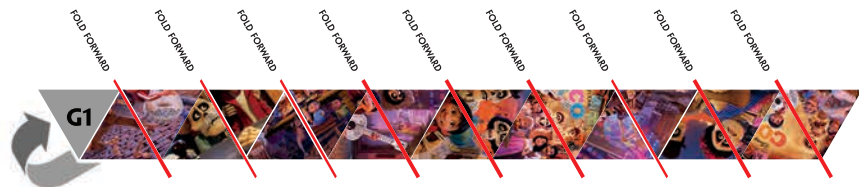
STEP 1

CUT OUT THE SMALL TEMPLATE, OR CUT OUT AND JOIN THE 3 PIECES TO MAKE THE BIG ONE. THEN, FOLD IT DOWN THE MIDDLE ALONG THE RED LINE



STEP 2

WITH 'G1' FACING UP, FOLD FORWARD ON EACH OF THESE RED LINES IN TURN



STEP 3

YOU SHOULD END UP WITH SHAPE THAT LOOKS LIKE THIS...



STEP 4

WITH THE 'BACK' FACING YOU, FOLD ALONG THIS LINE, FOLDING SIDE 'A' BEHIND SIDE 'B'

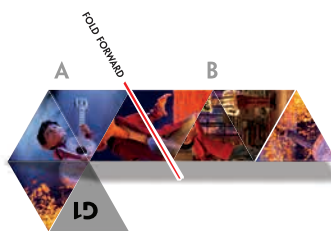


SO IT LOOKS LIKE THIS...



STEP 5

FOLD ALONG THIS LINE, FOLDING SIDE 'B' OVER SIDE 'A'

STEP 6

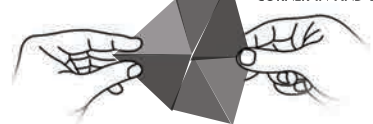
BRING 'G1' OUT FROM BEHIND SO IT SITS IN FRONT, THEN FOLD AND STICK 'G2' ON TO 'G1'



HOW TO USE IT

PINCH ANY CORNER TOGETHER...

...PUSH THE OPPOSITE CORNER IN AND BACK



UNTIL YOU HAVE A 3-POINT STAR...

...AND YOU CAN SEE A NEW IMAGE INSIDE



THEN 'PEEL' OPEN THE MIDDLE OF THE STAR...

...TO REVEAL THE NEW IMAGE

MAKE PAPER MARIGOLDS



"WHEN WE WERE INVITED TO TAKE PART IN DÍA DE MUERTOS IN MEXICO," SAYS DIRECTOR LEE UNKRICH, "WE SAW PATHS MADE OF MARIGOLD PETALS THAT STARTED OUT IN THE STREETS AND ENDED AT OFRENDAS-ALTARS WITH FAMILY PICTURES, FAVORITE FOODS AND SPECIAL OBJECTS. WE LEARNED THAT IT WAS ALL DONE TO HELP GUIDE THE SPIRIT OF A FAMILY'S LOVED ONE HOME."

YOU'LL NEED:



- GREEN PIPE CLEANERS
- SCISSORS
- ORANGE/YELLOW OMBRE TISSUE PAPER (OR ORANGE AND YELLOW TISSUE PAPER)



STEP ONE
UNFOLD ONE SHEET OF PAPER. CUT IT IN HALF DOWN THE MIDDLE.



STEP TWO
LAY YOUR TWO HALVES ON TOP OF EACH OTHER AND CUT THEM IN HALF TO MAKE FOUR EQUAL PIECES.



STEP THREE
STACK YOUR SHEETS. IF USING OMBRE PAPER TURN EVERY OTHER SHEET SIDEWAYS TO MIX UP THE COLORS. (IF USING ORANGE/YELLOW PAPER, ALTERNATE BETWEEN YELLOW & ORANGE LAYERS.) FOLD ONE SIDE OVER TO FORM A THIN STRIP.



STEP FOUR
AFTER YOU MAKE YOUR FIRST FOLD, FLIP OVER YOUR PAPERS TO MAKE ANOTHER FOLD. CONTINUE FLIPPING AND FOLDING UNTIL YOU HAVE ONE ACCORDIAN-FOLDED STRIP.



STEP FIVE
TIE A PIPE CLEANER AROUND THE MIDDLE OF YOUR STRIP TO HOLD THE FOLDS FLAT. MAKE SURE THE COLORED SIDE OF THE TISSUE PAPER IS FACING UPWARDS.



STEP SIX
CUT A CURVED ROUNDED EDGE ON BOTH ENDS OF THE STRIP. (THE CLOSER TO THE MIDDLE YOU CUT THE SMALLER THE FLOWER WILL BE.)



STEP SEVEN
FAN OUT YOUR FOLDS TO CREATE A ROUND SHAPE. CAREFULLY PEEL UP THE FIRST LAYER OF TISSUE ON BOTH SIDES AND PULL THOSE TO THE MIDDLE.



STEP EIGHT
KEEP PULLING EACH LAYER OF TISSUE UP CAREFULLY TOWARDS THE MIDDLE OF THE FLOWER UNTIL ALL THE LAYERS HAVE BEEN FLUFFED UP.



STEP NINE
FOLD THE PIPE CLEANER TOWARDS THE FLOWER PETALS AND TWIST IT TO FORM A STEM.



STEP TEN
CRUNCH THE PETALS TOGETHER TO SHAPE YOUR FLOWER. EXPERIMENT WITH MAKING DIFFERENT SIZES.

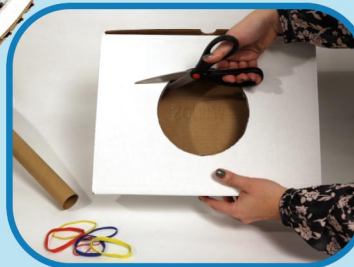
YOU'LL NEED:

- CARDBOARD BOX
- SIX RUBBER BANDS
- CARDBOARD TUBE (ONE FROM WRAPPING PAPER WORKS WELL!)
- SCISSORS
- MARKER



STEP 1

DRAW A CIRCLE IN THE MIDDLE OF YOUR BOX. (YOU CAN TRACE AROUND A DVD TO HELP YOU DRAW A CLEANER CIRCLE.)



STEP 2

HAVE AN ADULT CAREFULLY CUT OUT THE CIRCLE.



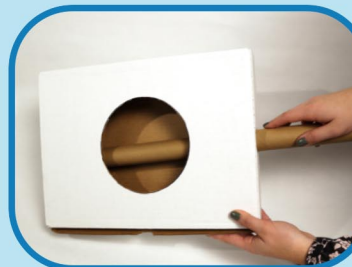
STEP 3

HAVE AN ADULT CUT A SMALL HOLE ON THE SIDE OF THE BOX. THIS SHOULD BE THE SAME DIAMETER AS YOUR TUBE.



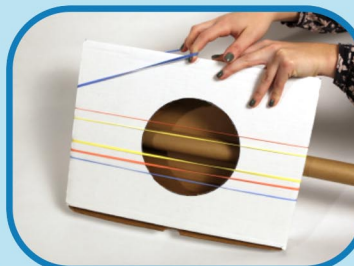
STEP 4

SLIDE THE TUBE THROUGH THE HOLE.



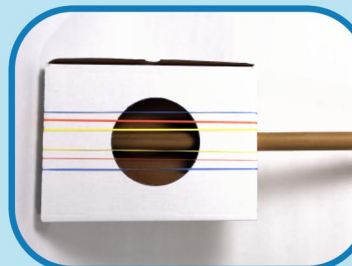
STEP 5

PUSH THE TUBE UNTIL IT HITS THE OTHER SIDE OF BOX.



STEP 6

CAREFULLY STRETCH SIX RUBBER BANDS OVER YOUR BOX - THREE ON EITHER SIDE OF THE TUBE. (VARYING THE THICKNESS OF THE RUBBER BANDS WILL CHANGE THE SOUND.)



STEP 7

PLAY YOUR GUITAR BY STRUMMING THE RUBBER BANDS. IF YOU WANT YOU CAN DECORATE YOUR GUITAR WITH ANY DESIGN YOU WISH.

🌿 Pan de Muerto & Hot Chocolate 🌿

What You'll Need:

Pan de Muerto (Servings: 6)

- ¼ cup unsweetened applesauce
- ½ cup mashed bananas
- 2 tsp maple syrup
- 2 tsp aniseed
- 1 tbsp orange zest
- ½ tsp salt
- 2 eggs
- ½ cup water
- 3 cups whole wheat flour
- 1 packet of yeast

Glaze

- ½ cup orange juice
- 1 tbsp maple syrup
- Sprinkle of beetroot sugar
- Natural food coloring (varied)

Hot Chocolate (Servings: 2)

- 2 cups of non-fat milk
- 2 tbsp unsweetened cocoa powder
- 1 tbsp bittersweet chocolate chips
- 2 tsp sugar
- ¼ tsp cinnamon
- 2 pinches of cayenne pepper
- Garnish Cinnamon stick, star anise, and sprinkle of cinnamon

How to Make It:

Pan de Muerto

- 1 In a large bowl, whisk together ⅓ cup of flour, aniseed, applesauce, bananas, and maple syrup.
- 2 In a separate bowl, combine water, eggs, and orange zest. Pour into dough mixture, adding an additional ⅓ cup of flour and whisking to combine.
- 3 Add another ⅓ cup of flour, along with packet of yeast, and combine with a whisk.
- 4 Add 2 cups of flour, and stir with a wooden spoon (dough will start to thicken).
- 5 Cover bowl with a dampened towel, and let sit to rise for one hour.
- 6 Sprinkle flour on your hands, and form 6 balls of dough, setting them on a baking sheet.
- 7 Save about ⅓ of the dough, using the remaining dough to form a criss-cross shape on top of each loaf.
- 8 Cover with plastic wrap, and let rise for another 45 minutes.

- 9 Bake for 30 minutes.
- 10 While cooling, make a glaze by combining maple syrup and orange juice in a small saucepan. Heat the glaze in a saucepan until completely combined and simmering.

Use a brusher to glaze the Pan de Muerto, and finish off with a sprinkle of beetroot sugar to serve.

Hot Chocolate

- 1 Place milk, cocoa powder, maple syrup, and bittersweet chocolate in a small saucepan.
- 2 Heat on medium heat, and whisk together until smooth.
- 3 Add in cinnamon and cayenne pepper, and whisk again.
- 4 Continue to heat on medium until the hot chocolate becomes fragrant.
- 5 Serve with garnishes and enjoy!
